



Curriculum Vitae of Johann Kim

Born in a Christian family in Seoul in 1959, he became a dentist after graduating from Seoul National University in 1984. He left the profession to become a church composer. He graduated from the Musikhochschule in Vienna in 1992, where he received several composition prizes. After having returned to Korea, he taught composition as an instructor at Cheon-An University, while serving as music minister at Hallelujah Christian Church in Korea, until he left for the USA to study the theology of worship at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville. He graduated from the Seminary with an M. Div. Worship degree in 2007, is currently a doctoral student (DMA) at the Seminary, Worship and Praise Minister at Vine Street Baptist Church in Louisville, and leads the International Youth Hymn Competition held in various nations like USA, South Korea, and China, as the founder of New Praise Support Society (http://newpraise.org).

"O Thou that Inhabitest the Praises of Israel" (Psalm 22:3) (premiere in English)

This song is based on two Bible verses, Psalm 22:3 and 1 John 4:8. These words describe God. According to these scriptures, God is holy and dwells in the praises of the people of Israel. He is love. To this Johann Kim added his own verse saying, "Thou inhabitest my own praise for Thee," which powerfully asserts the core notion of praise. For Kim, praise is and should be the place where God gladly dwells eternally. Further he concludes that praise is the invisible temple of God and praise ministry is nothing less than building the eternal temple for God to dwell in.

The style of this piece is apparently late Romantic, which is characterized by frequent use of chromatically altered chords and rather unexpected modulation. It is notable that the piano part not only accompanies the voice part but also praises God on its own, which is one of the important characteristics of how Kim deals with piano part in most of his vocal pieces, for he regards the pianist not just as an accompanist but as a praiser whose role is as crucial as that of a singer. Dong-Hoon Park is a devoted church musician who studied in various schools like Westminster Choir College, Eastman School of Music, and now is a doctoral student of church music at SBTS, as well as the music minister at Plum Creek Baptist Church.

"O Lord My God, When I in Awesome Wonder" for piano

This famous hymn proclaims powerfully the unfathomable greatness and beauty of God's creation as well as his amazing love for us revealed by Jesus Christ who died for our sins on the cross. Originally, Kim arranged it for the ensemble of tenor solo and David Men's Choir he led at Hallelujah Christian Church in South Korea. He then transformed it to a piano solo piece demanding a high level of skillfulness and artistry for the first prize winner of the Children's Piano Hymn Competition in 2001. As he made it a choral piece, he inserted a tenor solo part singing "Lord, please accept my praise!" between the third and fourth stanza as a humble plea which will be heard as an instrumental recitative in the piano piece. Hye-In (Gloria) Koh, Louisville YPAS music student from this summer, was the grand prize winner of 2001 Hymn Competition in Seoul, as well as the co-winner of 2003 Hymn Competition with her younger sister Young-In.

"Give Thanks" for flute and piano

Written by Henry Smith as a voice piece, it has been arranged by Kim for his daughter Hanna's flute recital in 2002. As the melody is repeated a second time, the key changes from major to minor without changing the original melody, alluding to the agony and ultimate sacrifice of Jesus Christ who enables us to receive God's mercy and love through his blood, which is an everlasting subject of thankfulness. Hae-eun (Silvia) Kim is a graduate of Dae-Jeon Baptist Seminary in South Korea, and is now a doctoral student of church music at SBTS.

Composer's testimony regarding this work

Something was missing, though I did not know what. As I was checking the list of music for my ordination about ten days ago, it seemed fine. On 23 May, nine days before the event Hae-Eun and Bo-Young were supposed to come to my home to have lunch together. But a few days earlier Bo-Young informed me that Prof. Soo-Joung Cha at Dae-Jeon Baptist Seminary in South Korea, a devoted church musician with great talent and enthusiasm, was with her. It was stunning news, so I gladly invited her as well, expecting somehow God's special providence on this matter. As planned, they came and we had a swell time, sharing testimonies with each other and hearing praise music.

After they had gone, I became kind of drowsy and took a nap. Then as I slowly woke up, something was moving in my mind, asking "Why don't you compose a new song for your own ordination and present it to God as a sacrifice of thanksgiving? You used to do that when you would have something to thank God for, even when it was your own birthday or when a

new year would begin, and do you think your ordination isn't a thing that can be compared with what you used to thank God for?" It was not a painful rebuke but a warm encouragement. And almost at the same time my mind was stuttering or hearing a chromatic descending motif veiled by soft harmony and modest ostinato-like iambic accompanying figure which reminds us of a kind of shy bridal procession, in F-major. I was thrilled to listen to this beautiful music with my inner ear, though the last half I had to struggle to figure out yet.

Simultaneously it became clear to me what my ordination is all about. It was, at least for me, giving my whole being to God, which is, in another word, a dedication. So the text began to be written as my personal prayer to God as the melody proceeded. Who will be singing this song was apparent to me, not only because Prof. Cha visited me just before this song was made and I found her CD great, but rather because the motif I heard was being heard with a soprano voice and the song is best fitted for a soprano. It took me just one day to complete the song and I must say it is not written by me, for I know the verse saying "He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God..." (Ps 40:3)

One last step was her willingness to sing this song, which she gladly showed after studying the music. As she told me, this song is not just for my own ordination. God does not work that way. In the course of time somehow I knew that this song would be primarily for all to-be-ordained servants of God, and also for all Christians who want to dedicate themselves to the ministry God assigns to each of them. So I decided to allow everyone to copy the notation of this song, so that whoever wants to sing this song may copy it and use it for the glory of God. I ascribe to my Lord all the glory and praise.
